The Top500 Project: Lessons Learned in Fourteen Years of Experience

Abstract:

The TOP500 project was started in 1993 to provide a reliable basis for tracking and detecting trends in high-performance computing. Twice a year, a list of the sites operating the 500 most powerful computer systems is assembled and released. The best performance on the Linpack benchmark is used as performance measure for ranking the computer systems. The list contains a variety of information including the system specifications and its major application areas. He has been involved in data processing and computer science for more than 45 years. He served as specialist, project leader, group and department chief during his 11 years at the Research Center in Jülich, Germany, from 1962 - 1973. For the following 26 years, he was director of the computer center at the University of Mannheim, Germany. Since 1998, he has been managing director of Prometeus GmbH, the service company specialized in the field of High Performance Computing.
